Kidsafe CArES Restraint

Dear Bill and Simon,

Thank you for your query and supplied data on the use and approval of the Kidsafe CArES device. I can inform you that the Kidsafe CArES restraint is acceptable for use on Australian registered aircraft under CASR (1998) 21.305(d) and CASR (1998) 21.502 on the basis that it is manufactured in a recognised country [CASR (1998) 21.012] and has been shown to provide an Equivalent Level of Safety to FAA TSO-C100b which is a recognised aeronautical specification.

The device is therefore acceptable for use under the FAA approval and as such, must be labelled and used in accordance with the operating instructions and any limitations so defined in the FAA approval under FAR 21.305(d).
